

Kodomo Robinai B Plus

Product features

 Your children may experience itchiness or redness in the eyes after using a smart phone/tablet for a long time, swimming, or being exposed to pollen or house dust. Kodomo Robinai Plus, when applied to the delicate eyes of your children, does not sting, but is soft and relieves itchiness and redness in the eyes and prevents eye diseases.

- When to use Kodomo Robinai Plus -



• To prevent eye diseases after swimming.



• To relieve tired eyes after using a smart phone/tablet.



• To relieve itchiness or redness in the eyes caused by pollen.

[Precautions]

Consult with a doctor

- 1. Consult with a doctor, pharmacist, or registered drug seller if you:
 - (1) Are receiving treatment at a clinic.
 - (2) Have ever experienced allergic symptoms after taking a drug.
 - (3) Have severe ocular pain.
 - (4) Are diagnosed with glaucoma.
- 2. Immediately stop using Kodomo Robinai Plus, and consult with a doctor, pharmacist, or registered drug seller showing this leaflet if you experience any of the following symptoms after using Kodomo Robinai Plus because it may be a side effect:

Affected area	Symptoms	
Skin	Eruption/redness, itchiness	
Eyes	Redness, itching, swelling	

- 3. Stop using Kodomo Robinai Plus, and consult with a doctor, pharmacist, or registered drug seller showing this leaflet if:
 - (1) Blurred vision is not relieved.
 - (2) Symptoms are not relieved after about two weeks of use.

[Indications] Tired eyes, conjunctival congestion, prevention of eye diseases (after swimming, when dust or sweat gets in the eyes), eye inflammation (e.g., snow blindness) due to ultraviolet or other rays, inflammation (sore) of the eyelids, discomfort while wearing hard contact lenses, itchy eyes, bleary eyes (increase in eye mucus, etc.).

[Dosage and Usage] Instill one to three drops for three to six times a day.

<Pre><Pre>cautions Related to Dosage and Usage>

- (1) Children should use the product only under adult supervision.
- (2) Do not let the tip of the bottle touch your eyes, eyelids or eyelashes. (doing so could cause the solution to become contaminated with eye mucus or bacteria.) Do not use the product if it does become contaminated.
- (3) Do not use the product while wearing soft contact lenses.
- (4) Use only as an eye drop.

[Ingredients/Contents]

| Active ingredients | Content (per 10 mL) | Function |
|-----------------------------|---------------------|--|
| Chondroitin sulfate sodium | 30mg | Prevents tear evaporation and retains moisture in the eyes, protecting the corneas from external irritation. |
| Dipotassium glycyrrhizinate | 8mg | Relieves inflammation and repairs the eye tissues for symptoms such as itchiness, tired eyes or soreness of eyelids. |
| Chlorpheniramine maleate | 1mg | A type of anti-histamines that relieves symptoms such as itchiness in the eyes or lacrimation. |
| Taurine | 10mg | A type of amino acids that provides nutrition to the eyes promoting the recovery of tired eyes . |

Kodomo Robinai Plus contains chlorobutanol, methylparaben, propylparaben, borax, boric acid, disodium edetate hydrate as additives.

Precautions for Storage and Handling

- (1) Store in a cool place away from direct sunlight closing the cap tightly.
- (2) Keep out of reach of children.
- (3) Do not transfer the solution to another receptacle. (Doing so may lead to misuse of the product or may affect its quality.)
- (4) Do not share the product with another person.
- (5) Do not use the product if it has exceeded its expiry date. Even before the expiry date, please use the product as soon as possible after opening the bottle. Depending on the conditions of storage, the ingredients may crystallize and form white deposits around the inside of the bottle's tip or on the inside of the cap. If this occurs, gently wipe off the deposits with a clean piece of gauze before using the product.
